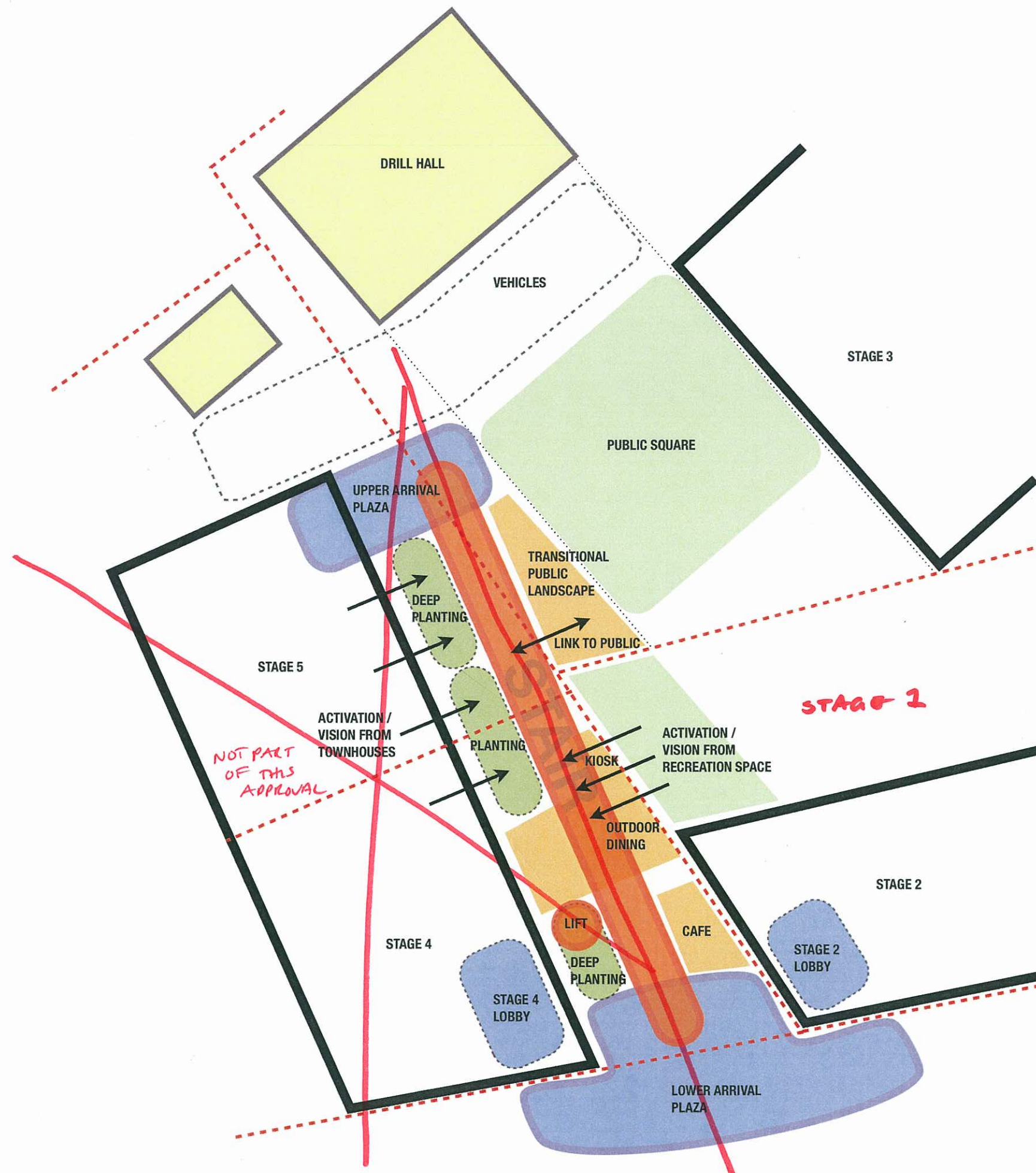
Public Stair

Concept Plan & Strategy

The public stair at the central spine of the Project Waters development provides a public address for the site and a linking element that bridges the steep topography of the site.

The stair itself is flanked by a variety of experiences, from a series of public lobbies to three adjacent large residential buildings and the associated pedestrian traffic, a corner cafe which activates the entrance and secondary kiosk and outdoor dining along the journey up the stair, along with a rich and diverse sub tropical landscape that provides shade and intimacy along the journey.

The mix of activation of the public stair space from overlooking apartments, residential lobbies, the cafe spaces, and adjacent recreational spaces, combined with clear sight lines, makes for an active and safe public access-way.
