APPLICATION UNDER SECTION 51 OF THE URBAN LAND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2007

Reference is made to the UDA Development Application lodged on behalf of **Metro Property Development Pty Ltd** on 19 July 2012 over land at 68 Brunswick Street, Fortitude Valley 4006 – formally described as Lots 5 and 6 on RP81335, Lot 1 on RP10553, Lots 11 and 12 on RP10552, Lot 13 on RP81335, Lot 101 and 102 on SP143465, and Lots 2 and 900 on RP8816117 (BCC Easements).

This letter serves to formally **withdraw** the existing UDA Development Application and request the Urban Land Development Authority's (ULDA) consideration of a consolidated UDA development application.

The proposed development represents **stage four** of the broader *Project Waters Master Planned Development*, and seeks a Development Permit for a **Material Change of Use for Multiple Residential (156 apartments)**.

Pursuant to Section 51 of the Urban Land Development Authority Act 2007 (ULDA Act), please find enclosed owners' consent, preliminary planning documentation and the applicable application fee. Please note that this application forms a **preliminary administrative application only**. A subsequent submission package will be lodged upon finalisation of consultant reports and will provide a more detailed assessment of the proposed development.

It is our determination that the applicable application fee is **\$33,000.00**, being for a major application of strategic significance. This amount has previously been paid by **Metro Property Development Pty Ltd** for the previous UDA Development Application. The ULDA have agreed to transfer this amount to the current consolidated UDA Development Application. All development scheme fees associated with the *Project Waters Master Planned Development* have been paid previously by Metro Property Development Pty Ltd as part of the Preliminary Approval application (Invoice Reference 0000608).
