LANDSCAPE CONCEPT



1.0 Location

The existing padmount transformer location, currently located on Lot 302 and adjacent the Newport development, is proposed to shift approximately 35m to the north.

The proposed location is within the existing stone pitch wall which places the padmount transformer outside the tidal zone and will not impact on vegetation values.

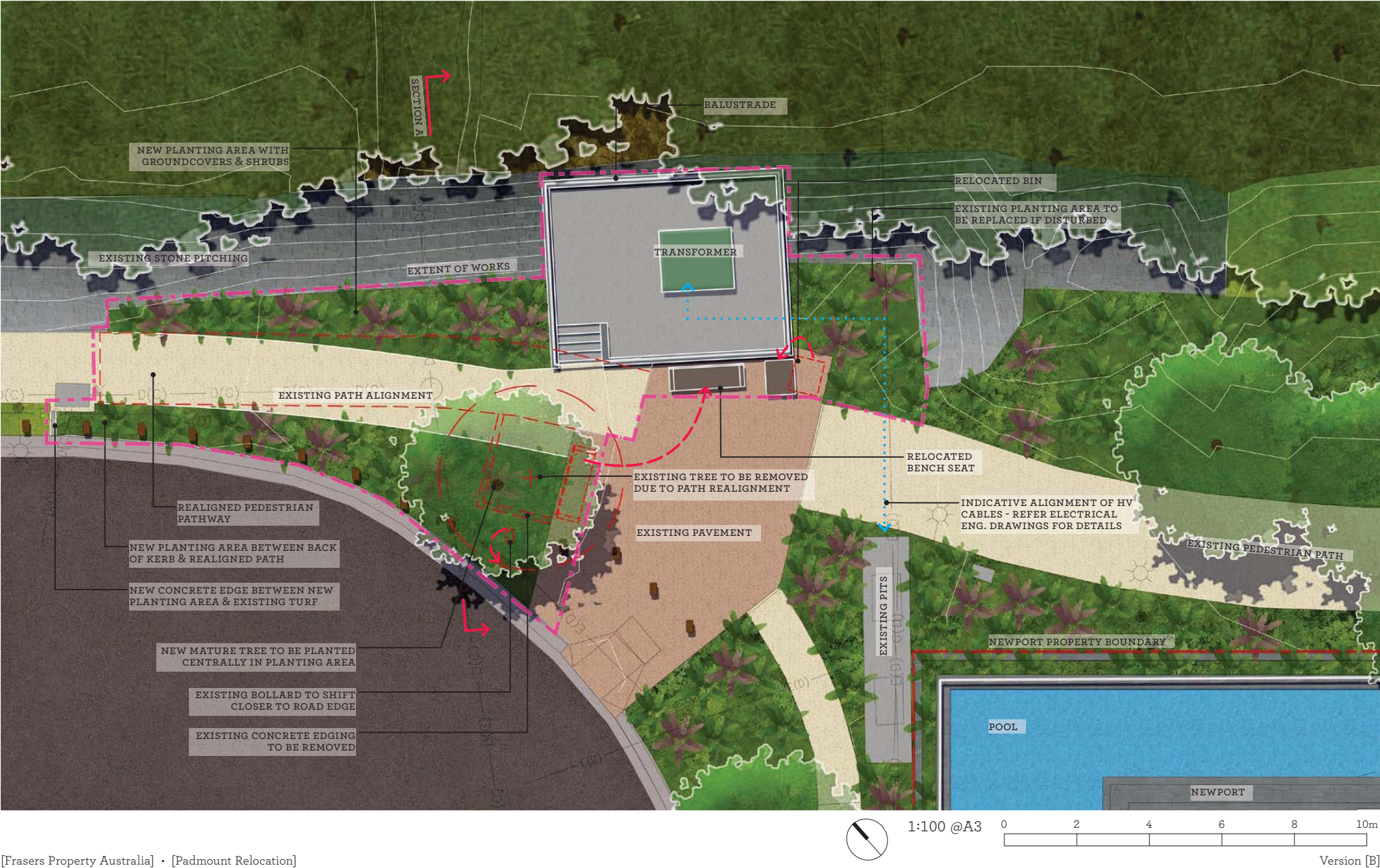

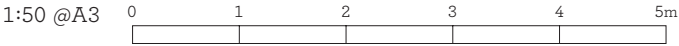
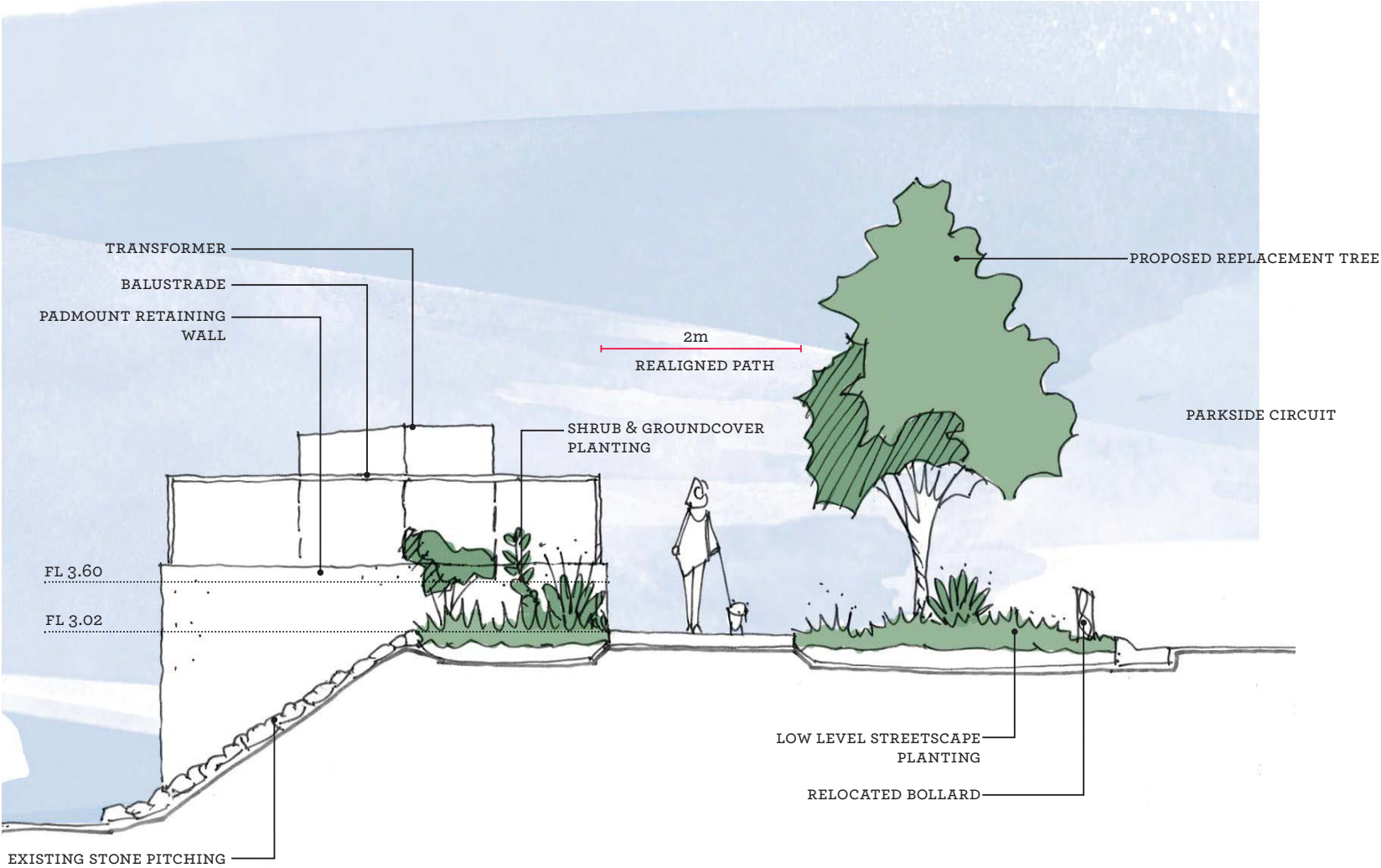
