### Proposed Schedule of temporary activities – July 2021

- Events – including but necessarily limited to:
  - Boxing or wrestling contests, display or exhibition
  - Cinema
  - Circus, including associated entertainments, training and classes
  - Drive-in theatre
  - Zoo park
  - Reception lounges/venue (includes wedding receptions, birthdays and other parties)
  - Fetes, fairs, fleamarkets and markets (held regularly throughout a year – if held once a year, must have an event permit)
  - Live artist (if involving amplified music BCC local laws related to noise in residential areas to be adhered to);
  - Mini golf;
  - Skating rink (including ice skating);
  - Sport and recreation event – e.g. roller derby, parkour, skateboarding, blokarting
  - Festivals – eg food and wine, cultural
  - Creative arts exhibitions – e.g. sculptural, public art
  - Trade show / exhibition
  - Travelling performances (other than circus)
  - Amplified music concerts – inside a building (BCC local laws related to noise in residential areas to be adhered to)
  - Outdoor amplified music concerts – only where a BCC Entertainment Event Permit has been obtained, and BCC local laws related to noise in residential areas to be adhered to)
  - Live music or entertainment of a minor nature (not an amplified music concert)
  - Ten-pin bowling
  - Theatre and theatre restaurant
- Transitional Activations – including but not limited to:
  - Office (eg Think Street)
  - Outdoor sport and recreation (eg Tennis Australia, River supported recreational activities)
  - Research and technology facility
  - Service industry
  - Food premises
  - Market
  - Warehouse
  - Car Park
  - Community facility

- Educational establishment
- Indoor entertainment
- Indoor sport and recreation
- Outdoor sport and recreation (eg Tennis Australia, River supported recreational activities)
- Park (Noting Maritime 3 delivered via exemption)
- Tourist facility
- Visitor accommodation (Pop up only – e.g. glamping)
- Shop
