Electric Vehicle Readiness The development is to include a separate dedicated electrical circuit (conduit and wiring) with a minimum of 20-amp supply into the garage or carport to enable the installation of Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment. Where not used for Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment at the time of installation, the circuit is to be fitted with a minimum 20-amp GPO outlet for future connection.	Prior to commencement of use.
4.	Rainwater Tank The rainwater tank must supply water to all toilets, laundry and have a connection for external usage and must have a backup supply from the main potable water system.
