### PDA Development Approval

This PDA Development Approval does not include assessment against the following:

- Building Code of Australia and does not permit building work to occur. Prior to the commencement of any building work, a Development Permit under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009* for Carrying out Building Work will be required.
- Plumbing and Drainage Act 2002*. Prior to commencement of any building work a Compliance Permit will be required from the City of Gold Coast Council.

### City of Gold Coast Council – Nominated Assessing Authority

For any conditions in this package that require the consideration of City of Gold Coast Council (CGCC), the applicant will need to submit the relevant forms, plans and/or reports and applicable fee to the Council.

## Noise and Dust Emissions

All development involving the emission of noise and dust from building/construction activities requires that the emission be in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*. Pursuant to Division 3 Section 440R of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*, a builder or building contractor must not carry out building work on a building site in a way that makes or causes audible noise to be made from the building work-

- a) on a Sunday or public holiday, at any time; or
- b) on a Saturday or business day, before 6.30 a.m. or after 6.30 p.m.
