Definitions

Integrated Tourist Attraction: *Means the use of premises for providing on site entertainment, recreation or similar facilities for the general public. It includes the use of land or premises intended for the conservation, interpretation and appreciation of areas of environmental, cultural or heritage value, local ecosystems and attributes of the natural environment. Activities typically:-*

- *maintain a nature based focus or product;*
- *promote environmental awareness, education and conservation;*
- *carry out sustainable practices.*

Facilities may include a tourist facility based around sustainability display and an environmental education centre, wetland, conference centre and associated accommodation, car parking and a community based nursery / market garden centre.
