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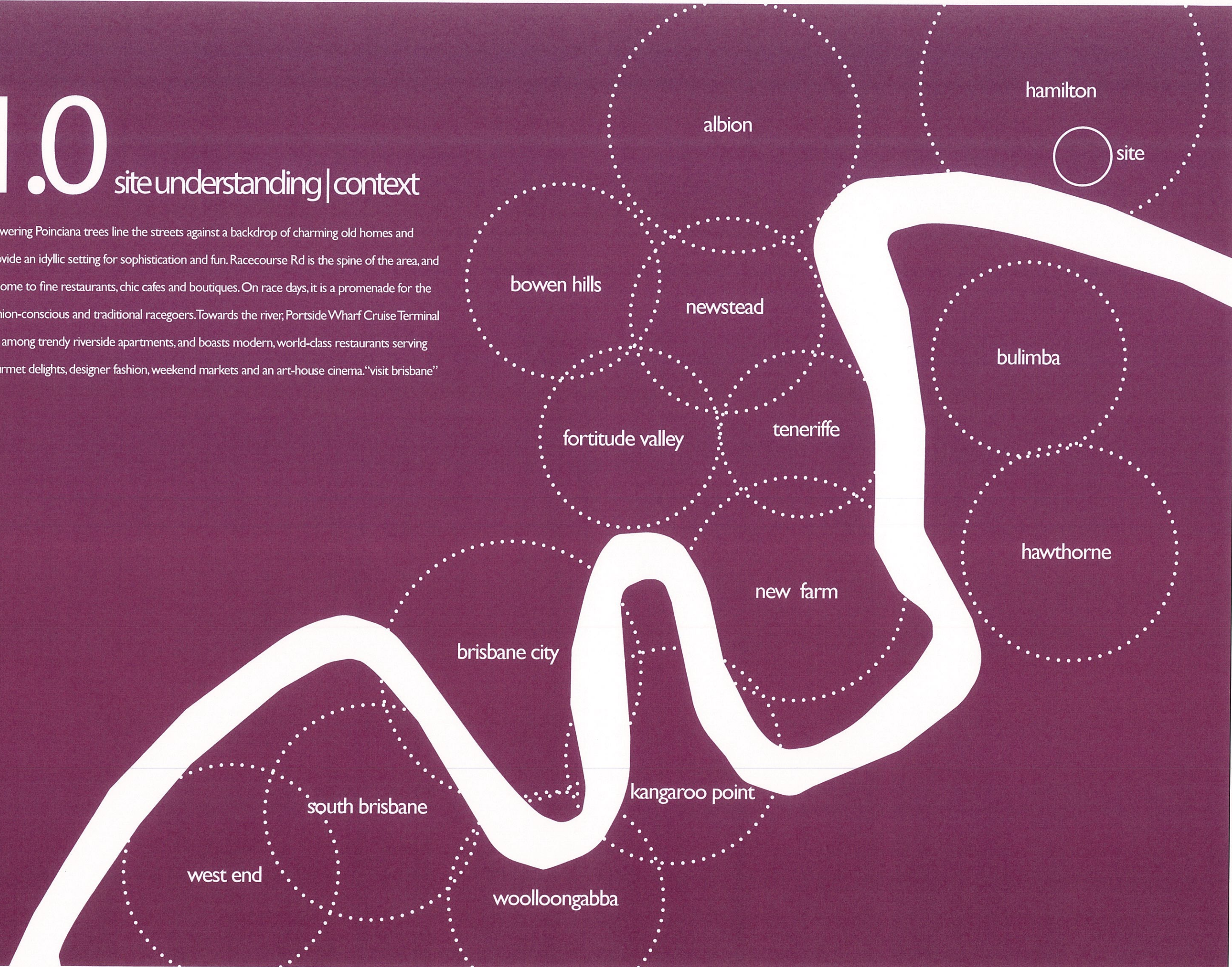

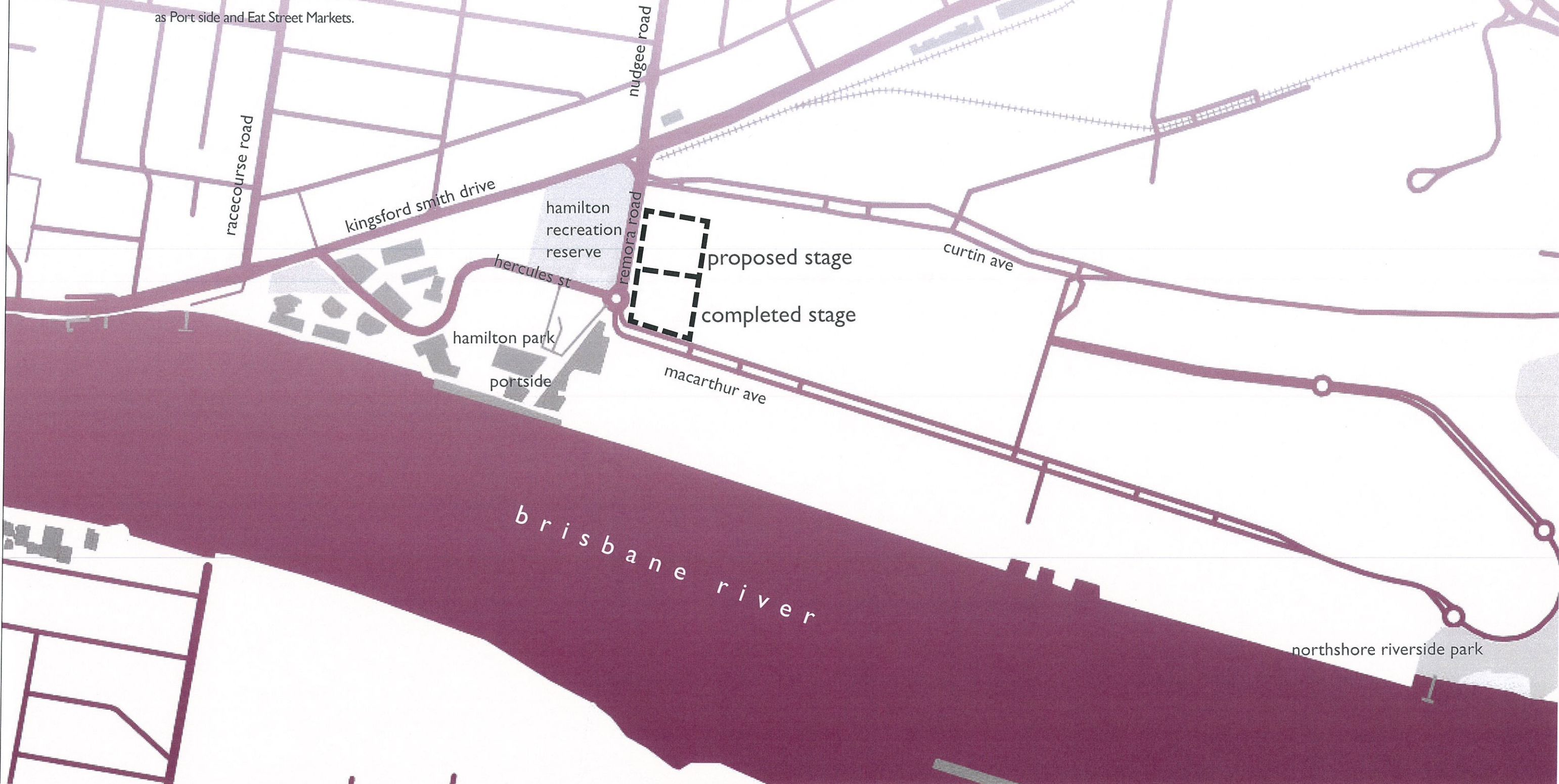

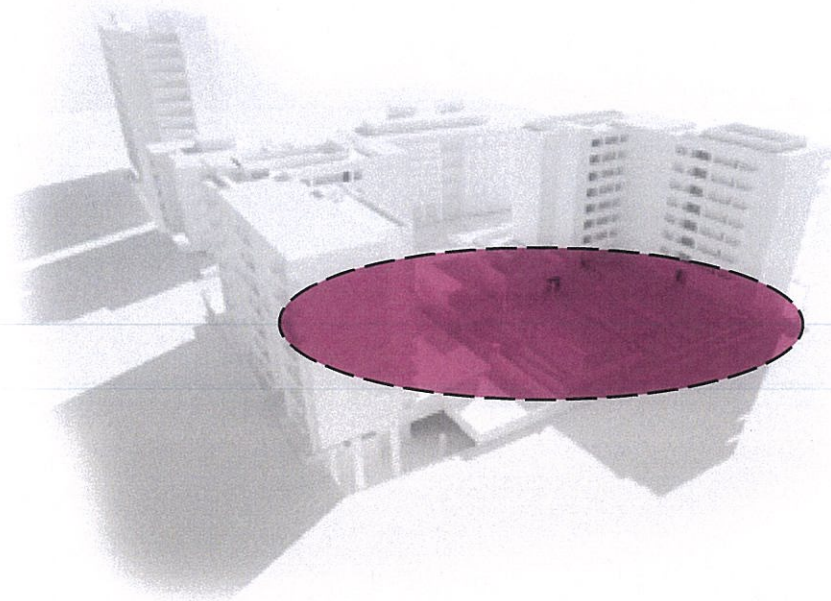
design visioning vision statement

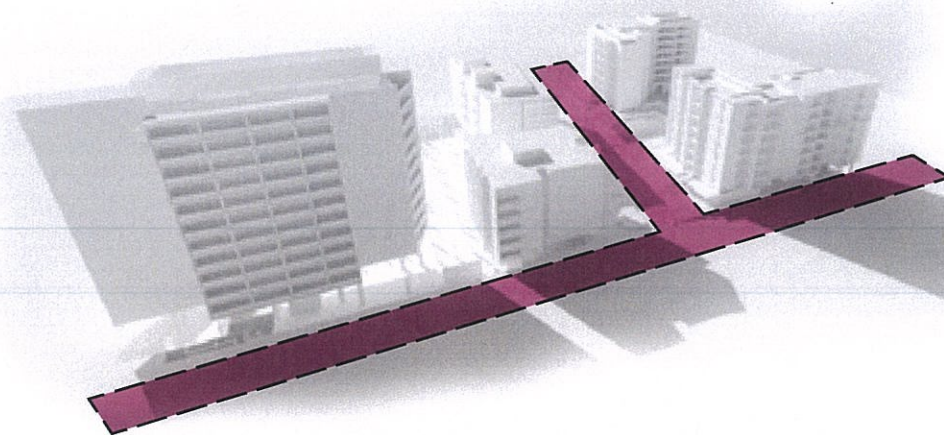
A central shared courtyard space with verdant and soft backdrop emphasise a residential living sanctuary within the hard surroundings of city buildings and busy streets which lack green open space.



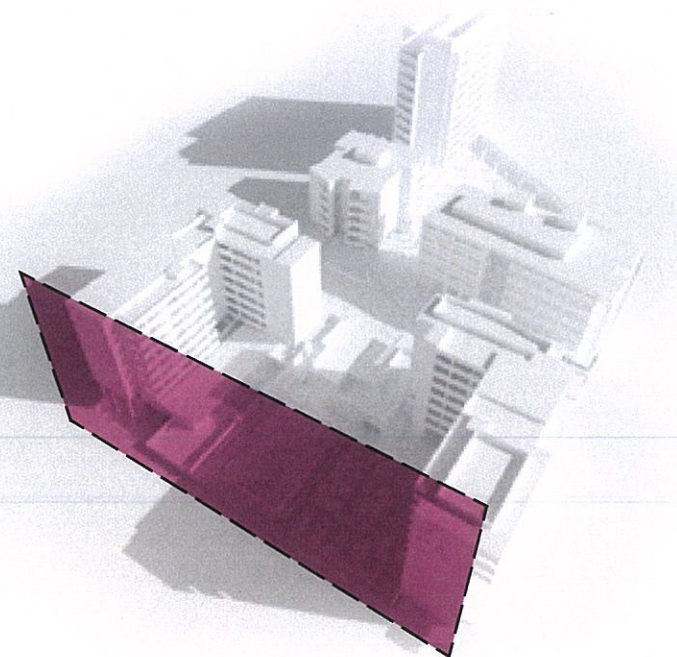

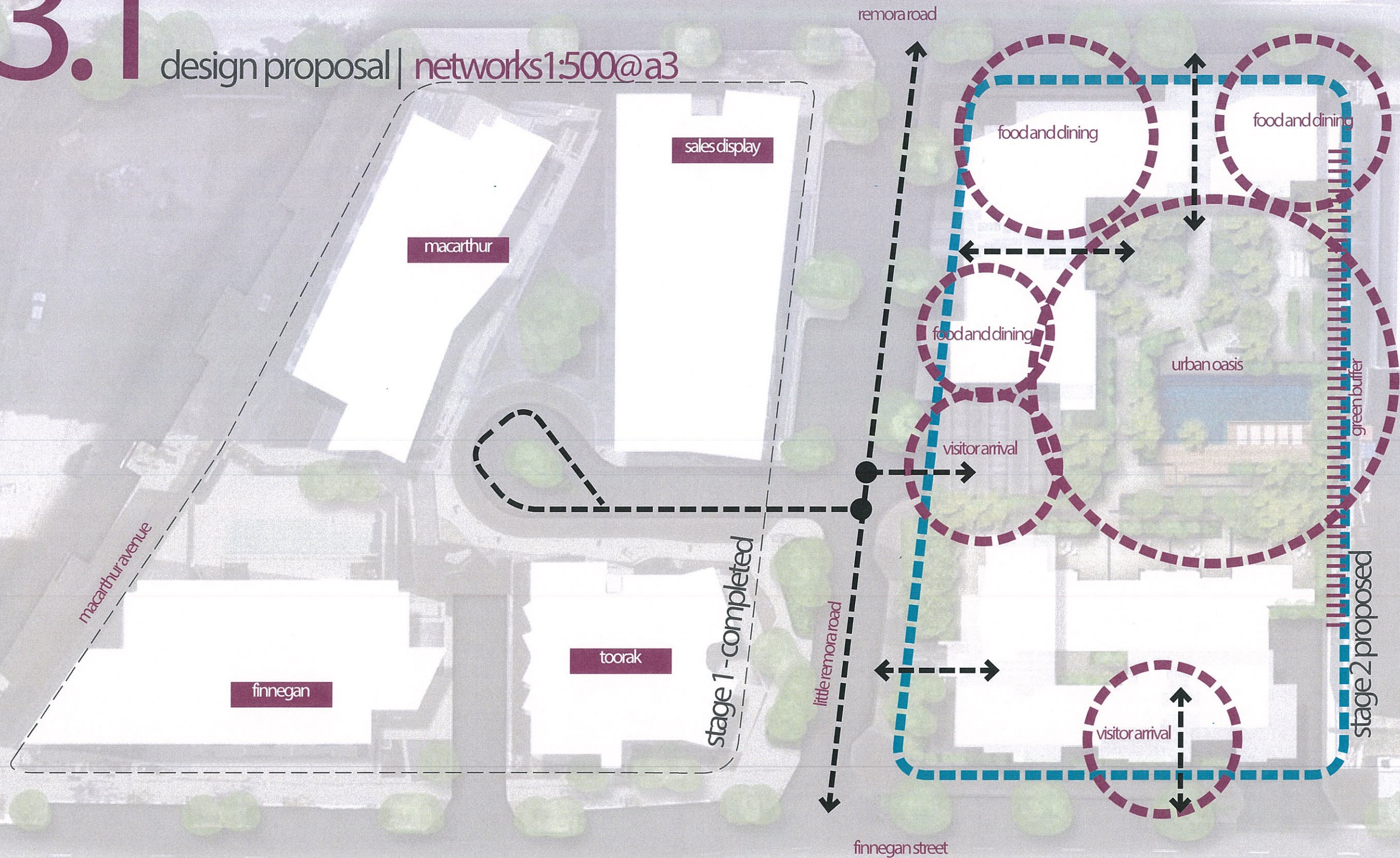

Incorporating the native streetscape palette, the streetscape will extend within the development, grounding the development within the urban context. Soft landscaping volume, within the development, that compliments the built massing, will be achieved through the incorporation of vegetation layering.
